Dear Victoria,

Thank you again for taking the time to meet with NetCoalition[1] and other stakeholders a couple of weeks ago. We saw that your Federal Register notice was published on February 23, and NetCoalition is preparing comments that I hope you will find informative and useful.

In the meantime, you mentioned that you were planning to travel to the San Francisco Bay Area to meet with stakeholders. I hope you will visit Google, Yahoo!, and eBay. Each of those companies is in relatively close proximity to one another. In order to set up a meeting with each company, please contact Laura Covington ([REDACTED]@yahoo-inc.com) or Margaret Stewart ([REDACTED]@yahoo-inc.com) at Yahoo!, Hillary Brill ([REDACTED]@ebay.com), David Drummond ([REDACTED]@google.com) or Johanna Shelton ([REDACTED]@google.com) at Google.

In addition, depending on how many days you have out there, we would recommend that you engage in a few separate meetings with various other stakeholders. We would divide those stakeholders as follows—

1. Public interest advocates and academics (probably best done in SF).
2. Small start ups (somewhere in the valley).
3. Venture capitalists, former CEOs, and other innovation leaders.
4. Leading technology IP litigators and practitioners.

Dividing the meetings in this way might make your time in San Francisco efficient, as you can have several meetings with a small group of experts in each meeting.
